## Pest Control

Dear Residents,

This notice is to inform you that bed bug treatment services have been scheduled for your unit. Proper preparation is required to ensure the treatment is effective. Please complete the following steps before the scheduled service date.

### PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- Remove all bedding, sheets, pillowcases, blankets, and mattress covers from beds.
- Wash all clothing, bedding, curtains, and fabric items in HOT water and dry on the highest heat setting for at least 30 minutes.
- After laundering, place cleaned items in sealed plastic bags or containers until treatment is complete.
- Reduce clutter throughout the unit to allow access to walls, baseboards, closets, and furniture.
- Empty dresser drawers, closets, and storage areas if instructed by management or the pest control technician.
- Move furniture at least 12 inches away from walls when possible.
- Vacuum carpets, rugs, mattresses, furniture, and baseboards thoroughly. Dispose of vacuum contents in a sealed trash bag immediately after cleaning.
- Do not move items from one room to another, as this may spread bed bugs.
- Remove all items from under beds.
- Ensure pets are safely secured during treatment.
- Residents may be required to vacate the unit during treatment and for the time period recommended by the pest control technician.

### IMPORTANT:

- Do NOT use over-the-counter bug bombs, sprays, foggers, alcohol, or other pesticides before or after treatment unless specifically directed by the pest control company. These products can interfere with professional treatment and may cause bed bugs to spread further.
- Failure to properly prepare the unit may result in delayed or ineffective treatment and could require additional services.
